Donation to Christian Action – Qinghai Children

We are pleased to learn of your generosity and desire to use the Chen-Si foundation to bless deprived and needy children. Thank you so much for the kind donation of EUR246.50 from your foundation, and warm blessings from our Qinghai Children. Our official receipt is enclosed for your records.

It is indeed wonderful that Si Lin whom you adopted as a little boy of 3 in 2002 has turned 18 in May this year and grown into a fine young man! Please give him my love and best wishes.

We give below brief updates of our Qinghai Children's Homes, for your kind interest:

Xining Children's Home

Our first children's Home presently cares for 110 orphans and abandoned children (including 29 in foster care). 202 of our children have been adopted so far by loving families overseas to USA, Canada, Netherlands, Finland, Belgium, Sweden and Spain and we are hoping more will go soon, as "home" is the best place for a child; 30 children have been adopted in China. The **Xining Children Rehabilitation Centre** which opened in October 2007 provides comprehensive services, including rehabilitation training and special education programmes, for our special needs children in the Home and in the community.

Bridging Programme

Currently, there are a total of 25 teenagers and young adults in Bridging Programme (6 in Xining Children's Home and 19 in Social Welfare Institute (XNSWI), which supports the Daily Activities Learning at Xining Children's Home to train the teenagers with prevocational training to prepare them for entering the sheltered workshop at XNSWI. At the same time, it will provide much better monitoring of each person's health and well being, plus ongoing training and development for the children entering adulthood at the Small Group Home in the Xining Social Welfare Institution.

Through this meaningful project, the needs of these children are brought to another level of care and concern from all the parties involved. This is a pilot project which has not been done by anyone else in Qinghai before.

Huangnan Children's Home

Our second co-managed children's home which opened in 2008 presently cares for 477 orphans (including 6 in foster care). Most of these are Tibetan orphans and our goal is to provide an improved and independent life through home care, education, health care, foster care, vocational training and counselling.

Haixi Children's Home

Our third Home, the Haixi Children's Home which opened in 2011 now cares for 17 orphans and abandoned children.

Guoluo Children's Home

Our 4th children's home in Guoluo which opened in 2012 now cares for 55 orphans and abandoned children (including 5 in foster care).

Hainan Children's Home

Our 5th children's home which opened in 2013 now takes care of 51 orphans and abandoned children.


Coming Challenges

Due to the immense need of the abandoned and disabled children in Qinghai, in 2015 we have signed a 10-year co-operation agreement with the Qinghai Government to take care of 36,000 at risk children and train up child care workers. We are seeking support to save and help these children.
